TOC = Test of Choice - you choose the test or tests you want to ride in the class/level. Show management has the right to combine, add, or delete classes, as dictated by entries.

<u>General Rules</u>: This show will follow USEF rules and USDF guidelines. Please see the USEF Rule Book for complete explanation of sport horse in-hand & dressage competitions (https://www.usef.org/ iframes/rulebook/2016.aspx and https://www.usef.org/documents/ruleBook/2016/08-DR.pdf). Submit a separate entry for each horse/rider/handler.

Rules for Sport Horse In-Hand Classes: Will be scheduled <u>before</u> the Dressage Under-Saddle Classes. Horses will be shown inhand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Horses under the age of two must be shown in plain leather stable halters. Bridles are optional on two-year olds. Bridles are mandatory on horses three years old and older. A bridle shall be a dressage or hunter type with snaffle bit with or without cheeks, keepers allowed, reins, and headstall with throatlatch. Noseband is optional. A split or single chain may be used with/or instead of reins. Conservative attire is recommended for the handler. The handler may carry one whip. IAW USEF DR206.6, helmets are required for all handlers, assistant handlers, and whip assistants of any age in in-hand classes.

Rules for Dressage Under-Saddle Classes: Will be scheduled <u>after</u> the Sport Horse In-Hand Classes. 2015 USDF, USEF and FEI tests will be used. For the entire show, a horse may be ridden up to 4 times at Introductory level and up to 3 times at other levels. A horse/rider combination may ride a test only once; however, the horse/rider combination may ride two or three different tests in a class/level. A rider may ride more than one horse in the same test and the rider may compete more than one horse in a class/level. Proper attire for a Level 1 Competition and approved tack are required; show coats are optional. ASTM/SEI certified helmet with fastened chin strap is required at all times when mounted on a horse.

<u>Arenas</u>: Warm-up Arena is outdoors stone dust. Show Arena is a 20m x 60m indoor with sand and fiber footing. <u>Discussion with the Judge</u>: Each in-hand or ridden test will be followed by a 2-4 minute personal discussion with the judge, providing a mini clinic opportunity.

Awards: 1st – 6th place ribbons will be awarded for each class.

- <u>Sport Horse In-Hand Champions</u>: A Champion ribbon and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded to the two horses with the highest scores from classes 1-5.
- <u>Dressage Under-Saddle Champions</u>:
 - o Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded to the two horse/rider combinations with the highest scores in each under-saddle division.
 - An Overall Show High Score ribbon and an Overall Show Reserve High Score Champion ribbon will be awarded to the two
 horse/rider combinations with the highest under-saddle scores of the show. If the High Score and Reserve are the same horse/rider
 combination, the third highest scoring horse/rider combination will receive the reserve ribbon.

Entries: Enter online at http://www.frederickdressage.org/6-may-2017---plantation-valley.html. Bring check made out to Catoctin Chapter of PVDA, current Coggins, and Hold Harmless Agreement to the show. If a rider scratches after the closing date or is a no-show, the ride fees are required. <u>Ride Times</u>: Times will be emailed on or before May 2, 2017, using the email address provided on the entry; they will also be posted at http://www.frederickdressage.org/shows-apr2017-oct2017.html and the URL under "Entries."

<u>Special Requests</u>: If special time considerations are needed, please indicate on the entry form. These needs will be accommodated, if possible; however, show management wishes to make every effort to complete an individual class in a contiguous fashion. Show volunteers who are also competitors will be scheduled at the beginning of the show.

<u>Directions to Plantation Valley Stables</u>: From 70, take exit 42 Middletown/Myersville. Go South on 17. Follow 17 to Middletown. Go straight thru the light in Middletown. Proceed to Quebec School Road. Turn right on Quebec School Road. Cross Picnic Woods Road. Follow Quebec School Road to Marker Road. Turn right on Marker Road then left on Mountain Church Road. Farm is on the left. Park to the side of the entry drive.
