# Tests/Classes: Current versions of:

- USDF/USEF/FEI dressage tests, and USDF/FEI Musical Freestyle tests (please provide own sound system)
- USEA and FEI eventing dressage tests
- WDAA Western dressage tests
- USDF/USEF Pas de Deus, Quadrille (please provide own sound system)
- Show management has the right to combine, add, or delete classes, as dictated by entries.

## **General Rules:**

- This show will follow USEF rules (<u>click here</u>) and USDF guidelines (<u>click here</u>, \$10 or free to USDF members).
- Submit a separate entry for each horse and rider.
- The fee is \$30.00 per ride; \$25.00 per ride for Catoctin Chapter members.
- For people and horse safety, absolutely **no pets**, leashed or otherwise, will be permitted on the show grounds.

#### **Dressage Classes:**

- <u>Number of Tests per Horse</u>: For this show, a horse may be ridden up to four times at Introductory Level only, up to three times at Training through Fourth Levels, and up to two times at Fourth Level through FEI.
- Riding the Same Test Twice: A horse/rider combination may ride the same test twice; however, the 2<sup>nd</sup> ride will be HC\*.
- <u>Rider Attire</u>: Safe casual riding attire (riding jackets are optional). Approved safety helmet with harness fastened
  and riding-safe footwear are required whenever mounted. Formal dressage attire is permitted.
- <u>Horse Attire</u>: See USEF rules. English saddles required for all USDF/USEF, FEI, or USEA dressage tests. Western saddles are required for Western tests.

## Arenas:

- Warm-up Arena: Outdoor non-fenced 20m x 60m sand/fiber arena.
- Competition Arena: Indoor with sand footing, cone and pole dressage court.

Discussion with the Judge: Each ridden test will be followed by brief comments by the judge, if time allows.

#### Ribbons:

1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons will be awarded for each class.

#### **How to Enter the Show:**

- <u>Click here</u> to enter the show online via the FADS website. Submit current Coggins and release form via the online form or bring to the show. On show day, bring a check made out to **Catoctin Chapter of PVDA**.
- These shows are on the honor system if you scratch after the posted closing date/time (or are a no-show), you agree to pay the ride fees. Mail the fees to Leslie Raulin, 2027 Gapland Rd., Jefferson MD 21755 (checks made out to Catoctin Chapter of PVDA). By entering the show, you agree to this statement.

Ride Times: Will be posted on the FADS web site (<u>click here</u>) and emailed Wednesday before the show, at the latest.

## **Special Scheduling Requests:**

- Some riders have special scheduling requests due to trailering arrangements, trainers that are riding and coaching, riders with two horses, etc. Although not guaranteed, every attempt will be made to honor these requests, as follows:
  - o If a class can be scheduled at a time frame requested by the rider, this will be done.
  - If the class cannot be scheduled in this time frame, every attempt will be made to schedule special request rides BEFORE the balance of the class; this is necessary so other riders do not have to wait for the class to finish
  - o If a special request ride cannot be scheduled before the balance of the class, the ride can be HC\*, if agreed to by the rider.
- Please note that special scheduling requests involving a wide variety of tests can be very difficult to honor.
- Also please note that scheduling occurs after the closing date/time; therefore, a ride that is scratched due to a special request that cannot be honored will be considered a scratched ride and the ride fee must be paid.
- If you must depart before your class finishes, please make arrangements to pick up your ribbon(s) (a friend at the show, pick up at a later date) or provide \$5.50 packaging, postage & handling cost to have the ribbon(s) mailed to you.

#### **Late Entries:**

- If the show is full on or before the closing date, no late entries will be taken unless the late entries would fill scratched ride(s).
- If the show is not full by the closing date, the closing date may be extended a day or two during which time entries will be accepted that will not be considered late.
- After the final closing date, if the show is not full, late entries will be accepted without scratches; however, the late entries would be scheduled at the end of the show and might be HC\* rides.
- There is no late entry fee.

**FADS Season-End Awards:** Awarded by level and rider status to rider/horse combinations that ride in at least two of the 2024 FADS shows. <u>Click here</u> for information.
